# PASTOR ANDRES UPDATE

#### April 25:

The first few days of treatment have gone well. There are many different side effects coming at him from all the different drugs he is on at the hospital, but Pastor Andres is feeling as well as he can at this point. Everyone at Rush has been very kind, supportive and compassionate. Thank you to everyone that has reached out to him and Amy. They have been overwhelmed with everyone's prayers, generosity & love!

#### April 18:

On Monday, Pastor Andres underwent a minor procedure to place a port-a-cath in his chest. This eliminates the need for him to be poked every time blood needs to be drawn or an IV needs to be started. Everything went well and as expected. On Wednesday, he had a follow-up visit with his oncologist who confirmed with him and Amy that his cancer is limited to his nasal area and his treatment will include a combination of chemotherapy and radiation. For a couple of different reasons, he will need to be admitted to the hospital for 4-5 days at a time to receive his treatments, and will have several weeks off between rounds. His first round begins on Monday, April 22. Thank you to everyone that has been praying for Pastor Andres. He enjoys hearing from you - please do not hesitate to reach out to him.

#### BOD UPDATE - April 2024

The Board of Directors (BOD) is the governing body of Saint Paul Church and School. We meet monthly to discuss various topics, set policies, and review financials. The BOD is composed of an elected secretary, an elected treasurer, and 6 elected general members. The term is 2 years and members can be re-elected for a total of 6 consecutive years. The (elected) Secretary is in charge of keeping accurate minutes of all BOD meetings and congregational meetings. Niki Wood (elected May 2018) is the current Secretary. The (elected) Treasurer works with the Business Manager to keep accurate financial records, as well as to submit regular financial reports to the BOD and to the congregation. Lori Yelvington (in this position since 2022) is the current Treasurer. Of the 6 elected general members, an internal election is held for Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson. The Chairperson (Bryan Yelvington) presides over all BOD and congregational meetings and the Vice-Chairperson (Ryan Kelley) performs the duties of the Chairperson if they are not available. The current elected BOD members are: Bryan Yelvington (elected May 2020), Frank Beraurer (elected May 2020), Don Mathias (elected May 2022), Lynn Fisher (elected August 2023), Kevin Mueller (elected August 2023), and Ryan Kelley (elected August 2023). Highlights from this month's meeting include:

• We started our meeting with a devotional led by Pastor Bo.

We talked about "One" – this is someone with whom we are praying for and walking through life.

Quarterly, we meet with one of the ministry leaders. This month, we welcomed Eric Young- he is the 5<sup>th</sup> grade teacher, athletics director, and assistant principal. He updated the BOD on how the year has been going, including an outlook towards summer camps. He highlighted the importance of sportsmanship in our athletics programs. Mr. Young also discussed long-term projects within his department.

• We reviewed year-to-date financial information.

• We heard updates from Pastor Bo, Principal Koenig, Business Manager Mike Haas, and the Board of Elders

# TIME, TALENT, & TREASURE

#### FINANCIAL UPDATE THROUGH MARCH - YEAR 2023/2024

As we head into the final months of our fiscal year, the Board of Directors and Finance Ministry want to update you on our financial status.

First, the good news. Our mortgage is below \$600,000 and we have a healthy balance in our Rainy Day fund.

Second, we need your help. With just a couple more months left in our fiscal year, we are behind our budget by about \$56,000. There are a few factors that have put us in this position. We did not have as strong of a month in December compared with previous years. Second, as our ministries have grown, so have our expenses, including salaries, benefits, and operational costs. The increase to tuition this past year has certainly helped to offset these costs, but we remain behind budget. As many of you know, our church covers approximately 50% of the expenses for the school, which is one of our most important ministries.

Through the Glory of God, so far this year we have been able to support our school, outreach ministries, and our community. We have 265 amazing children at our school who fill us all with joyour hallways are filled with learning and laughter. We are fortunate to have a wonderful staff that we greatly appreciate. Church attendance has been increasing over the past year, and we were Blessed to have so many of you worshipping with us during Easter.

As we head into the last couple of months of our budget, we ask that you pray about how you may be able to help Saint Paul strongly end our fiscal year so that we are in a solid financial position for all of the exciting things to come this next year. If you have any questions, please contact the Board of Directors. Thanks to significant help from our finance ministry, our board of directors is diligently working on Saint Paul's financial future!
